 Nina Marshall ,daughter of Andrew Thompson Marshall by his second marriage to Rosina C. Bowen (Marshall), wrote the following,"I Nina Marshall Faragher, am the second child of seven children by Andrew Thompson Marshall and Rosina Caroline Bowen.My father was born in Auburn, Cayuga, New York. He had one sister, Edna Ida, whom he called"Nina". His mother died and his father remarried. "Papa", as we children called him, took his \$1,000.00 from the bank and came west to Ogden, Utah. He boarded and roomed in the Watts home, where he met Sadie Watts ,his first wife whom he later married. They had two children, a little girl who died young and Andrew (named after my father whom they called"Drew"). My father was called"Andy". Drew was raised by Grandma and Grandpa Watts. "Drew" owned two drugstores in Ogden. He married Florence...
